

FIFTH NORDIC YOUNG EARLY MUSIC ENSEMBLE COMPETITION



Every second year NORDEM (the Nordic Early Music Federation) arranges the EAR-Iy music competition. The overall aim of EAR-Iy is to encourage the formation of new early music ensembles and to stimulate an interest in early music among students throughout the Nordic and Baltic region. Early music means medieval, renaissance or baroque repertoire, performed according to the latest HIP standards. The criteria for selection are musical quality, detailed stylistic knowledge, communicative authenticity, and, in the final round, overall artistry. Entrants must be born no earlier than 1 January 1985.

The Final round of **EAR-ly 2018** will be held 21–22 September in Copenhagen, Denmark, hosted by Copenhagen Renaissance Music Festival. The competition invites applications from – vocal, instrumental or mixed ensembles consisting of a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 8 members; – vocal or instrumental soloists, performing either alone or with 1 accompanist.
